### About Inclusive Health

- In 2007, the North Carolina General Assembly passed Session Law 2007-0532, which created the North Carolina Health Insurance Risk Pool (NCHIRP).
- The NC Health Insurance Risk Pool began marketing its Plan on October 20<sup>th</sup> under the name **Inclusive Health**.
- The Plan took effect January 1, 2009, making North Carolina the 35<sup>th</sup> state to have a risk pool.
- The mission of Inclusive Health is to provide affordable health insurance coverage for North Carolinians who face high insurance premiums because of pre-existing high-risk health conditions.
- The Inclusive Health is a not-for-profit organization and is not a state agency or instrument of the state.

- CoreSource, whom MedCost has had a relationship since 1994, has been selected as the administrator for the Inclusive Health, including customer service for any network-related inquiries.
