

## Re: Prescription Relief Program

You may have recently faced a change in your health or prescription benefits plan. While you no longer have health coverage, you are still able to get discounts on your prescriptions. You can now use the Prescription Relief Program powered by Optum Perks. The Optum Perks Prescription Relief Program is a free prescription discount service that gives you access to savings on prescriptions, and continued access to home delivery (where applicable) if your health coverage has run out. This program is not insurance.

**To use this discount,** simply show your current benefits card and a prescription from your doctor at any network pharmacy, just like you did during the time you had coverage.

- **Do not throw away** your existing prescription benefits card. You should keep using this every time you fill a prescription.
- If you no longer have a prescription benefits card, you may visit
   <u>perks.optum.com/prp</u> and print, text, or email an Optum Perks card. You can
   then use this digital card each time you fill a prescription. This card is not
   insurance.

The card will run a discounted price that will save you money on your prescriptions. This amount will not count towards a deductible. Think of it as a discount to the cash price on the prescription.

You can save on prescription medications, which include brand-name, generic, and doctor-prescribed over-the-counter drugs. The covered network includes over 60,000 pharmacies, including major chains and local stores.
